Peatlands Climate Action Scheme - Attymon Co. Galway

Submissions before Thursday 1st August 2024.

The Department of Environment, Climate and Communications approved grant funding of €108 million in 2020 for the scheme **'Peatlands Climate Action Scheme (PCAS)'**. Under this scheme, enhanced rehabilitation has commenced on fifty-six bogs since 2021 and it is proposed that rehabilitation will commence on an additional thirteen bogs in 2024. A rehabilitation plan must be prepared and part of the process includes consultation with stakeholders and affected parties.

To facilitate this consultation process, a Draft Rehabilitation Plan and associated Map Book for Attymon Bog is now available on the Peatlands Climate Action Scheme website at the following location: <u>https://www.bnmpcas.ie/2024-bogs/</u>
